

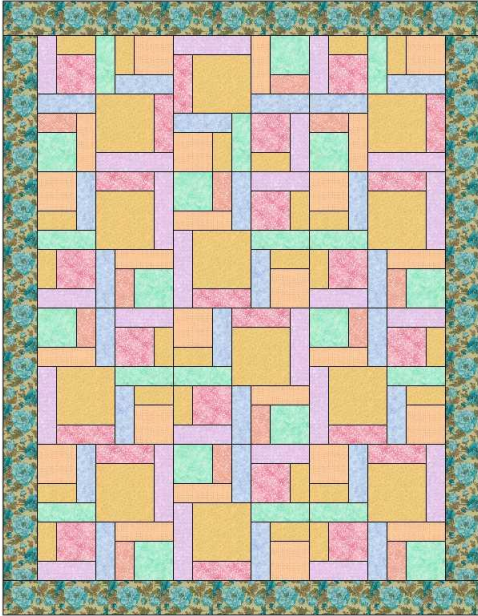
# Purple Brick Road

Finished size approx. 63" x 81" (with 4.5" borders)

You need

1 yard fabric for borders

15 fat quarters (approx. 18" x 21")



Quilt Layout (12 blocks + border)



Block layout (17.5" x 17.5" finished)

This pattern turns 15 fat quarters into 12 blocks, making a twin/full quilt top.

Press the fat quarters, sort them into four stacks, three stacks with 4 layers, and one stack with 3 layers. Each stack should have a varied assortment of fabrics. (Don't put all the similar fabrics into the same stack). Align each stack carefully with the selvedge on the left and the lower edge aligned as well as possible. Trim these two sides to square up the lower left corner as your starting point. Use the first diagram below 3 times, to cut the three 4-layer stacks. Use the second diagram to cut the short stack (3 layers).

(12) 8" x 8" (A)

(12) 10.5" x 3" (C)

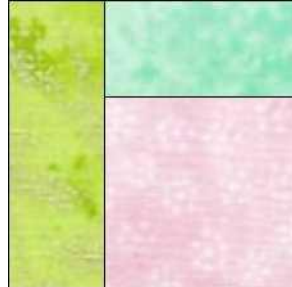
(72) 8" x 3" (E)

(36) 5.5" x 5.5" (B)

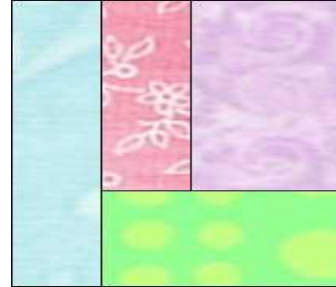
(36) 5.5" x 3" (D)

### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

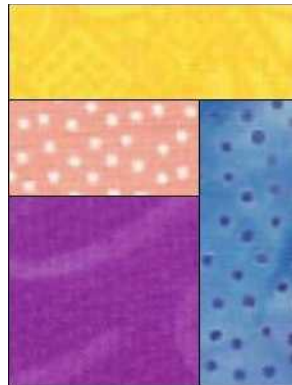
Make 12 unit G  
using one (B), one  
(D), and one (E)



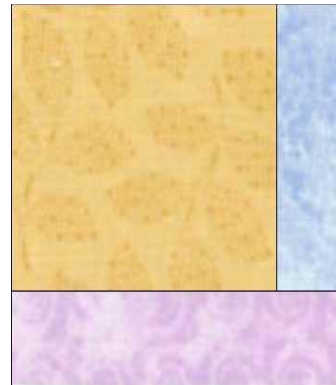
Make 12 unit H  
using one (B), one  
(D), and two (E)



Make 12 unit I  
using one (B), one  
(D), and two (E)



Make 12 unit J  
using one (A), one  
(E), and one (C)



Referring to the block layout on the first page, create the left hand side by sewing a unit G above a unit I (pay attention to where previous seams run). Create the right hand side by sewing a unit H above a unit J, paying attention to previous seam lines. Try not to have the same fabric recur more than twice in a block but don't worry too much about it. Assemble twelve blocks by seaming the left side to the right side. Blocks should be 18" by 18".

### QUILT ASSEMBLY

Lay out your twelve blocks in 4 rows of 3 blocks, scattering colors as you find pleasing. Any blocks may be rotated as desired.

Sew each row, then sew the rows together. Quilt top should be approximately 53" by 70.5".

Cut the one yard of fabric into 7 crosswise strips, each 5" wide. These will be your outer borders.

Piece the border strips to match the sides and attach long borders, then piece and attach the top and bottom borders. Finished quilt top should be approximately 64" by 79".
