## **Rectangular Log Cabin Medallion Quilt**


Finished size approx. 60" x 80" (with 5" borders)


## Kit contains

1 set wide border strips (5" – 8" wide x 280" total)

18 light 3" strips (720" total), 22 dark 3" strips (880" total)







Quilt Layout (16 blocks + border)

Right-hand block (make 8)

Left-hand block (make 8)

## Cut the **DARK** strips into

16 15 ½" segments

16 13" segments

16 10 1/2" segments

16 8" segments

16 3" squares

Cut the **LIGHT** strips into

16 13" segments

16 10 ½" segments

16 8" segments

32 5 ½" segments

NOTE: **READ THIS BEFORE STARTING TO SEW!**: you will create 16 blocks, each 13" x 18". You need **8 right-hand blocks** and **8 left-hand blocks** (mirror image) as shown above.

Sew 8 units with one dark 3" square on the end of a light 5 ½" strip.

Following the right-hand block diagram, add a dark 8" strip on the RIGHT side.

Add a 5 ½ inch light strip to the TOP of this unit. Continue adding a dark strip on the RIGHT and a light strip on the TOP following the block diagram until you have 10 total pieces in the block. Create 8 blocks this way.

Now you need to make 8 left-hand blocks, starting with the same two-piece unit, adding dark strips to the LEFT side and light strips to the TOP side to complete 8 more blocks.

Arrange the 16 blocks as shown on the quilt diagram, and assemble in 4 rows of 4.

Piece the border strips as needed to create two top and two side borders. Add the borders.
