HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES

Approx. 66" by 80" (with 5" borders)

This kit contains

One set of wide border strips (5" to 8" wide) totaling at least 280"

80 assorted squares, 8 inches square

(40 light/medium and 40 medium/dark)







Match two contrasting squares right sides together. On the lighter square, draw a diagonal line, then stitch ¼ inch on each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line to form two squares. Press toward the darker side.

Create 80 total squares this way. These squares should measure just a bit over 7 % square. You can trim them down to exactly 7 % or use as is, the finished quilt will be about 1" longer and wider.

Assemble the blocks in 10 rows, each with 8 blocks. You can arrange the light/dark triangles as shown, or place them randomly.

Assembled top should measure approximately 56 by 70 inches.

Piece the border strips as needed to match the size of the top. Add the borders.

Finished top should be approx. 66" x 80" (or larger if your borders strips were wider)
